Dear Superintendents, Administrators, and Fine Arts Coordinators,

Assistance League® Tulsa is again proud to extend to Tulsa area public school fine arts teachers the opportunity to apply for a Betty Bradstreet Arts Education Award for art, drama and music classroom projects. Please forward this letter to fine arts teachers in your district.

All public school teachers of fine arts in the Tulsa area are eligible to submit a proposal. A selection committee of Assistance League® Tulsa volunteers will review the applications and provide as many awards as funding will allow. Committee members will schedule a site visit to meet each teacher receiving an award and to observe the children enjoying items purchased or plan for another process if distance learning is still in effect in the spring of 2021.

Teachers are invited to apply online at altulsa.org/programs/BettyBradstreet. Complete the Award proposal and return it with an attached budget including copies of estimates for supplies from vendors to bettybradstreet@altulsa.org.

The Award proposal must be received by **October 19, 2020**. Maximum funding for an individual proposal is \$2,500. This money may not be used for salaries, individual scholarships, field trips or transportation. All proposals will be considered and selections will be made by **October 30, 2020**.

There may be another opportunity to apply for this award at a later date due to the unusual circumstances with distance learning vs onsite learning, but teachers will only be allowed to submit one application during the school year.

Applications will only be accepted online on the Assistance League® Award Proposal Summary Forms.
