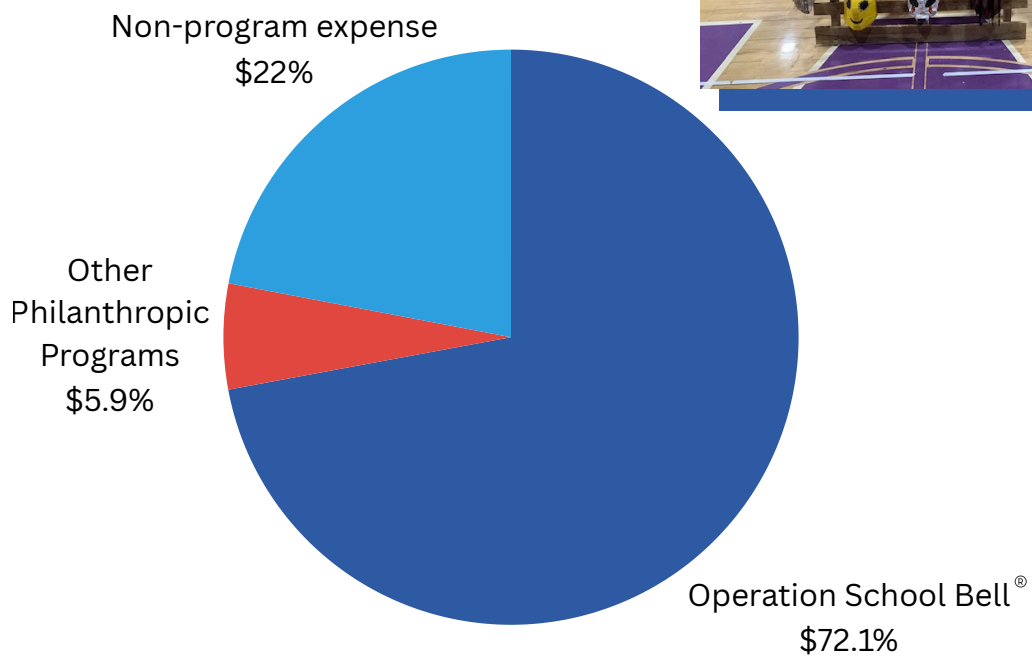
## WHO WE ARE:

## Operation School Bell®

- 23,597 students from 138 schools in 13 districts were served by OSB
- An estimated 3,000+ unduplicated Tulsa Public Schools elementary students from 46 schools were clothed through volunteer efforts at our building.
- 1,705 elementary students from 12 outlying school districts and 71 schools were clothed at area Walmart stores.
- 7,040 books were distributed to elementary students.
- 26,386 uniform shirts (2 per child) were delivered to 35 TPS elementary schools
- Personal Care and Clothes Closets provided essential items for students' immediate needs at 90 school sites.
- 8,699 TPS secondary (junior and high schools) students received clothing and other essential items
- 225 TPS high school students were recipients of OSB ALTSA (ALT Scholar Awards) in the amount of \$39,140 to cover concurrent enrollment fees

## Betty Bradstreet Arts Education

- \$70,807 was awarded to area fine arts teachers to support classroom needs, impacting over 17,739 students

## STEM Education

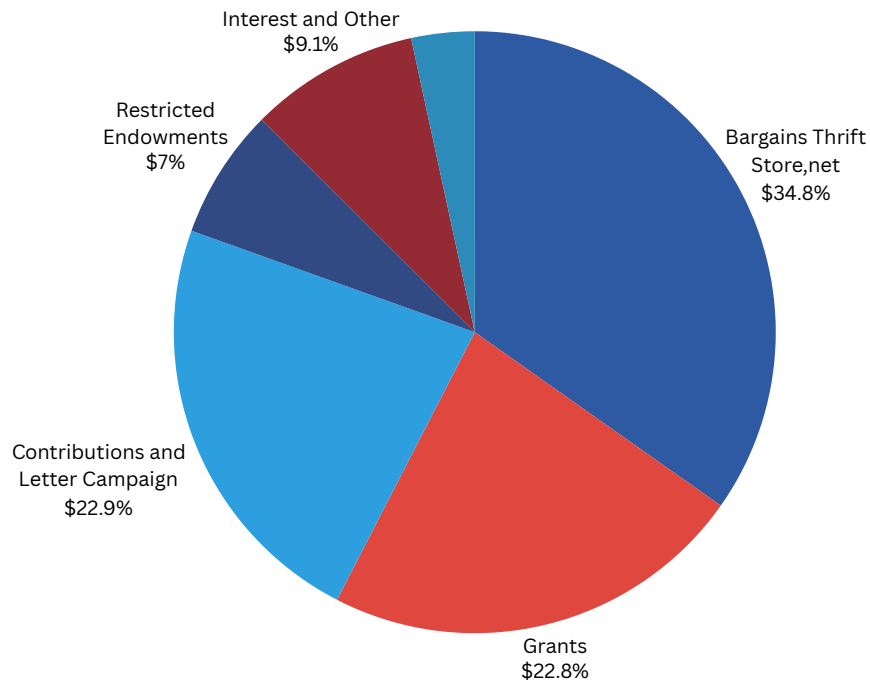
- 13,246 STEM-in-a-bag kits were assembled by AL Tulsa volunteers and distributed to 6,325 students in area schools

## Community Partners

- Working in conjunction with Mental Health Association Oklahoma, clothing, household essentials and other wish list items were provided to four MHAO living facilities.
- Through our partnership with LIFE Senior Services, underserved senior citizens received holiday gifts, tote bags of household supplies and two picnic tables were dedicated at the new LSS building.

Assistance League Tulsa is primarily funded through grants, community and volunteer contributions, and proceeds from the volunteer-run Bargains Thrift Shop. The organization does not receive government or United Way funding. Committed to fiscal stewardship and long-term sustainability, Assistance League Tulsa seeks to balance its funding streams to avoid over-reliance on any single source, as demonstrated in the chart above.
